- Install Smoke & Carbon Monoxide Alarm in Garage.
- Install Proper ADA Approved Handicap Grab Bar in Bathroom Shower & Tub, Consult Technician Before Buying Any Grab Bar All Grab Bars Are Not The Same.
- Install Proper ADA Approved Handicap Grab Bar Around Toilet.
 (Some Models Allows To Install L Shape Handicap Grab Bar)
- Install Special Door Stopper To Hold The Door For Wheelchair Access And Safety of Handicap And Elderly People.
- Install Security Door Seal (Step Guard) For Easy Step-in or Step-out At Main Entrance Way. Install Lever Type Door Handle Avoid Turn Door Knobs.
- Install Ceiling Fan in Every Room Let it Run on Slow Speed All The Time To Circulate The Air To Reduce The RADON GAS (Silent Killer) inside the home. Test Shows There is Enough RADON GAS in This Area.
